

PEREPELIUK TROPHY COMPETITION **(Revised Edition, November 2001)**

The Perepeliuk Trophy is awarded, every two years at the National CYMK Convention, to the most active Senior CYMK Local in Canada. The Perepeliuk Trophy Competition promotes an all-around program with equal emphasis on all categories.

Categories:

1. Culture
2. Religion
3. Leadership
4. Publications
5. Public Relations
6. Financial
7. Registration
8. Inter-organizational Activities
9. Miscellaneous

Scoring:

The Perepeliuk Trophy Competition will be judged by the National CYMK Executive on the basis of the Perepeliuk Trophy rules as revised in November 2001.

The competition deadline is July 1, 2011.

All activities conducted after the Competition deadline will be credited towards the next competition. A scoring key will be used by the National CYMK Board to score the submissions and to choose the winner of the competition. The key will not be made available to the Locals. There is no ceiling on the amount of points obtainable. The Perepeliuk Trophy cannot be awarded to more than one Local at any National Convention; that is, there can only be one competition winner. The decision of the National CYMK Board will be final.

Submissions:

- The Perepeliuk Trophy representative from each Local Executive shall be the Secretary.
- Submissions must be sent directly to the National Executive.
- All submissions must include the required two signatures to be accepted as authoritative - the Secretary and one Advisor or Chaplain.

How to Prepare Submissions:

The Secretary can copy the categories listing on his or her computer. As CYMK activities happen, the Secretary can enter the activity under the appropriate

Category and Section listing.
