Dear Children, Beloved Boys and Girls,

He once even said, that if anyone should harm you, a mill-stone (Google it. Your parents probably have to look it up too) should be hanged about their neck and they should be drowned in the depth of the sea. That's how much He loves you!

I want you, together with all the other children in our Church, to raise your voice in prayer at least once a day so, that they hear you in Heaven. Your parents will help you say this prayer:

"In the Name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen!" (3 times)

Jesus, Son of God, have mercy on us. We love You and we believe, that You love us. We know, that You love Your Father and the Holy Spirit, you Mother, Mary, your friends, the Holy Apostles, the Holy Myrrh-Bearers and many others. WE also love many people. Protect us, our mama and tato, our babuni and didusi, our whole family, our Church, our country, our nation and the whole world from the virus, that is making people, that we love, sick. Hear us Lord, and have mercy on us.





Gideon, the temporary leader of the people





Monetary donations and food items were merged into one total, and parishes were not singled out. All contributions are important as we give what we are able. We know the total amount was much greater than noted here, so we are trusting each church can submit their donations from April 18 to April 30, 2020 to their eparchial representative or to sonia.udod@umanitoba.ca.

The following are guidelines to make the process easier for your parish:

- See the following link for a list of Food Banks near you at https://www.foodbankscanada.ca/ or feel welcome to choose a foodbank/soup kitchen you are familiar with.
- Please register as a parish of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of Canada (Name of Your Parish). This is a way our Church's collective and active mercy in supporting local food banks can receive recognition in our communities.
- If possible, have bins delivered to your parish/parish hall from your local food bank.
- Request canned/boxed food items, non-perishable food items, or bags of groceries.
- Promote the Food Drive through church bulletins; post the flyer in churches/ parish halls, and on social media. Use the tag line UOCC LentenFoodDrive for public relations.

- Record the weight of your food bin, and send the weight to your eparchial representative.
- We encourage you to <u>send/post</u> <u>pictures/comments</u> of how the Food Drive in your parish is proceeding to Dobr Sonia or Lesia Skyba who can post on the UOCC Facebook Page, Twitter, and the UOCC website, or post on your own social media accounts.


